PROBE BEGINS
INTO DEATH OF

A magisterial inquiry is underway into the suspicious death of Radha Gayatri, a software professional from Vizianagaram district in Dehradun on June 17.

Mussoorie senior divisional magistrate Rahul Anand commenced the inquiry on July 7, based on an order issued by Dehradun district collector Ashish Chauhan.

Radha Gayatri's parents, Sudhakar and Satyavati, are pursuing a legal battle in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, seeking justice for their daughter. Sudhakar has alleged that her husband, Srisharan, murdered her in a premeditated act, and that another person may have assisted him in reaching the location at 11pm on June 14.

AP government has submitted to the HC bench that it is only inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) for the operation and maintenance of the Rushikonda buildings. Murthy Yadav has in his PIL alleged that Coastal Regulation Zone norms have been violated.

40 STUDENTS
FALL ILL AFTER
FOOD POISONINGDC CORRESPONDENT

Around 40 dental students of the Government Dental College in Kadapa fell ill following a suspected case of food poisoning after consuming food served at the girls' hostel on Tuesday night.

Several students complained of nausea, vomiting and uneasiness soon after dinner. They were immediately shifted to the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Kadapa (RIMS) for treatment. Hospital authorities said all the students were recovering and their condition was stable.

Parents alleged that poor-quality food served in the hostel caused the incident, while student unions blamed the mess contractor for negligence and demanded strict action against those responsible.

Food safety officials inspected the hostel kitchen and food materials and interacted with the affected students to collect details. Students said this was the first such incident at the hostel. Officials said a detailed inquiry would be conducted and a report submitted to the district collector.

Investigation is on. Meanwhile, Kadapa district in-charge minister S. Savita directed officials to provide the best treatment to the hospitalised students. She spoke to collector, DMHO and the superintendent of RIMS, seeking a report on the incident. Officials said all students were stable.

PDSO opposes SIR duty
to teachers as learning hitARUNA | DC

The Election Commission of India's Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls is drawing criticism for its impact on government schools.

Teachers across not just AP but India have been given the duty of revising the voters' list, pulling them away from classrooms and disrupting education. This has come amid schools already struggling with severe staff shortages.

The worst sufferers are the single-teacher government schools that cater to education in villages and remote areas, where children of poor and marginalised communities study. The question of education does not arise when the teacher is busy elsewhere,

Progressive Democratic Students' Organisation (PDSO) has raised the pertinent question of who will compensate for the lost learning. India's national average teacher-student ratio is supposed to be 1:30. But the reality is different in many places. More than 110,000 schools operate with only a single teacher, who juggles with multiple classes and subjects. The burden is immense.

Assigning non-teaching duties only worsens the situation. Teachers are reporting mounting stress and exhaustion, while students are left with diminished instruction and fewer opportunities for individual attention.

The legality of assigning SIR duties to government school teachers, particularly the understaffed and single-teacher schools, has

also been questioned. Section 27 of the Right to Education Act explicitly prohibits assigning non-teaching duties to teachers, except in three cases: the decennial census, disaster relief, and election duties for legislatures or parliament. SIR programme does not fall under these exemptions in AP and most other states.

PDSO contends that assignment of teachers for SIR work is both unlawful and a violation of students' fundamental right to education. The organisation insists that teachers be relieved of SIR responsibilities and alternative government staff be appointed to carry out the special intensive revision of the electoral rolls. It has called on the government and ECI to ensure uninterrupted teaching.

Rush for borewells as
El Nino dries up Seema

40K wells drilled in 2 months; reservoirs see low levels

Severe drought conditions, attributed to the El Niño effect, have triggered a sharp increase in borewell drilling across Rayalaseema as farmers struggle to save standing Kharif crops amid falling groundwater levels. More than 40,000 borewells have been drilled in Kurnool, Nandyal and Kadapa districts since April 25.

Officials estimate that 400 to 500 borewells are being drilled every day and warn that another 40,000 may be sunk by August if rains continue to fail. "We have no option but to drill deeper as our sweet lime orchard is drying up. I have dug a borewell up

to 810 feet, which cost me around ₹1.2 lakh," said farmer N. Balamaddi Reddy. Senior geologist V. Maheswara Naidu warned that groundwater had fallen to critical levels and advised farmers to avoid water-intensive crops.

Farmers said spending ₹1.2 lakh to ₹1.4 lakh on each borewell was adding to their financial burden. On the other

hand, Delayed monsoon rains have reduced water storage in Andhra Pradesh reservoirs to 413.42 tmc, or 37 per cent of total capacity, against 57 per cent a year ago.

Surplus Godavari water is being diverted through the Pattiseema and Tatipudi projects to the Krishna delta to support irrigation for 13 lakh acres during Kharif.
