LEARNING AND LIFE AT POWERGRID

Engineer Trainees move through classroom instruction, on the job training at project sites and sub-stations, behavioural skill development, role plays and management games, talks by industry experts, industrial site visits, sports and cultural events, and a structured mentoring programme.

Training is anchored by the POWERGRID Academy of Leadership, set on a 23-acre campus at Manesar, Gurugram. The Academy holds Category-I, Grade 'A' status and is recognised by the Central Electricity Authority, Ministry of Power. Trainees learn on live assets and simulators, including a 400/220 kV GIS sub-station, the POWERGRID Transmission Experience Centre, the National Transmission Asset Management Centre and the POWERGRID Advanced Research and Technology Centre.

Postings are largely at on-site locations across the country. Job rotation and planned development interventions carry people from the first posting through to senior leadership, which POWERGRID has consistently grown from within.

Candidates having qualification degree from a discipline other than those as mentioned above are not eligible to apply. However, the Corporation reserves the right to take a final decision in considering an Engineering discipline eligible in case different from those mentioned above. Final Year / Semester students who expect their final results by **31.08.2027** are also eligible to apply, provided they have obtained minimum 60% marks or equivalent CGPA in aggregate of all semesters/years up to pre-final examination. In case of selection, their candidature shall be subject to their securing minimum 60% marks in essential qualification. Such candidates need to mention their marks up to pre-final examination while filling up the online application form.

COMPENSATION PACKAGE

The Corporation offers a very attractive pay package and is one of the best in the Industry. Selected candidates will be placed in the pay scale of Rs.40,000/- 3% - 1,40,000 (IDA) during the one-year training period. They shall be paid Basic Pay of Rs. 40,000/- along with IDA, HRA and Perks @12% of basic pay during training period. The approximate CTC per annum shall be as follows:

During Training	Rs. 11.00 lakhs
After successful completion of Training	Rs. 22.50 lakhs

The CTC shall vary depending on location of posting and other terms and conditions of appointment.

On successful completion of training, the candidates will be absorbed as Engineer in E2 scale - Rs. 50,000/- 3%- 1,60,000/- (IDA).

On regularization, Compensation package includes Basic Pay, Dearness Allowance, Perquisites and Allowance as per cafeteria approach, Performance Related Pay, Company Leased Accommodation / Company Quarters or HRA, Reimbursement of monthly conveyance expenditure, digital services reimbursement, uniform, laptop facility, PF, Gratuity, Pension & Leave encashment, Group Insurance, Group Personal Accident Insurance, etc.

SERVICE AGREEMENT BOND

The selected candidates will be required to execute a service agreement bond to successfully complete the prescribed training period and thereafter serve the organization for at least three years. 5. SC/ST/PwBD/ Ex-SM/ Departmental candidates are exempted from payment of application fees. Candidates are required to login to their candidate login section and then deposit **non-refundable application fees of Rs. 500/-** through online mode only. On submission of application fees, the application process will be treated as complete.
6. Candidates will be required to retain their GATE 2027 Admit card and GATE 2027 Score card for verification at every stage of recruitment process including pre-employment medical examination/ Joining etc. in POWERGRID.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. Only Indian Nationals of age 18 years or above are eligible to apply for POWERGRID.
2. Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he / she fulfills the eligibility criteria and other norms mentioned in this advertisement.
3. Such graduates who are desirous of pursuing further studies on the basis of GATE 2027 or need extension of joining time in case of selection need not apply.
4. Essential qualification should be recognized in India and from a recognized Institution or University.
5. Vacancies are for requirement all over the country, mostly on-site locations. Selected candidates shall be assigned for OJT and final postings accordingly. Candidates are liable to be posted at the discretion of management to serve at any of the company's offices / establishments / Subsidiaries/ JVs/ units or any other government departments, statutory body or public sector undertaking anywhere in India or abroad.
