CSR EFFORTS BY POWERGRID FOR COVID 19 CARE

In this direction, Northern Region-II of POWERGRID has been facilitating the needy in the states of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, parts of Haryana and UTs J&K and Chandigarh.

District Administration, Bilaspur and Himachal Pradesh have been provided with Pulse Oximeters, oxygen cylinders, sanitizers, masks and oxygen regulator amounting to ₹3.30 lakh. A blood storage refrigerator has also been provided to Government Sarwal Hospital in Jammu apart from a mobile x-ray unit provided to Civil Hospital in Moga.

POWERGRID has also given masks and an oxygen concentrator to Government Hospital Panchkula.

As part of COVID-19 measures in villages, two oxygen concentrators have been distributed among the Gram Panchayat Village Damjan near New Wanpoh Sub-station of POWERGRID. Apart from this, sanitisers and masks have been distributed to Chief Medical Officer of Fatehabad and Primary Health Centre, Chattergam near Wagoora Sub-station.
